Interconnection Far and Near!

The February theme of Interconnectedness brings to my mind all those I love who live long distances from me. I moved from Salt Lake City to St. George in 1985 for the relief from arthritis pain that the warmer weather would provide. I left my parents, siblings, other relatives, and friends. Being far away and trying to maintain a relationship brings a different



kind of connectedness. I enjoy living in the same city with my daughter, but my sons and grandchildren live miles away from me. It takes effort for anyone to stay in touch and, when we do have those precious times of being physically together, they seem more important. It's easy to take the closeness for granted when you live near the people you love. And distance can lead to not even knowing each other, if you're not careful.

I've learned that interconnectedness doesn't just happen because you are related or care for each other. You have to create moments of connection. Similarly, our connection to God, the Creator, the Holy Spirit is there because we are part of the All-That-Is, but our closeness is only determined by our effort to make contact. The illusion we have of separateness from our spiritual family (God, all humans, and all life) can only be healed by our doing something about it. Just as we need to contact our loved ones to stay in touch, we contact Spirit through prayer. Being a good listener builds relationships, including listening to the Divine through meditation and contemplation. To stay close, we show interest in what others are doing. Likewise, if we want to know the Divine, we can read about others' means of connection and school ourselves on the nature of God. Getting together and showing care binds family and friends. Love, compassion, and service strengthen the interconnection with our spiritual family.

My spiritual practices of prayer, meditation, reading, and writing keep me close to Spirit. I enjoy taking advantage of the many opportunities that help me feel connected to the Divine and my spiritual family at CSL St. George. I need all of you to be there to feel fully interconnected.
